



**SECTION VI - HEALTH HAZARD DATA**

**Route(s) of Entry:** Inhalation (Y) Skin (Y) Eye (Y) Ingestion (Y)

**Health Hazards (Acute and Chronic):** Direct contact with product concentrate may cause slight irritation to eyes.

**Carcinogenicity:** NTP (N) IARC Monographs (N) OSHA Regulated (N)

**Signs and Symptoms of Exposure:** This product has low toxicity. Only large quantities may have adverse impact on human health. Inhalation – Inhalation of product vapor or mist may cause irritation of mucous membranes in nasal passage and throat. Skin – Prolonged or repeated exposure not likely to cause significant skin irritation. Eye – Irritating. May cause slight eye irritation. May cause very slight transient (temporary) corneal injury. Ingestion – May cause nausea, vomiting, severe abdominal pain, or diarrhea. Main hazard, if ingested, is aspiration into the lungs and subsequent pneumonitis.

**Medical Conditions Generally Aggravated by Exposure:** N/D

**Emergency and First Aid Procedures:** Inhalation – Immediately move individual away from exposure and into fresh air. Seek immediate medical attention. Keep person warm and quiet. If person is not breathing, begin artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, administer oxygen. Skin – If irritation develops rinse affected skin area with water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists after washing. Eye – Promptly wash eyes with lots of water while lifting the eye lids. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues. Ingestion – DO NOT induce vomiting. Get medical attention immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**SECTION VII - PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE**

**Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled:** Contain spill. Neutralize and absorb small amounts. Collect and return large amounts to shipping container. Rinse spill area with water. Keep product out of sewers and watercourses by diking or impounding. Advise authorities if product has entered or may enter sewers, watercourses, or extensive land areas. Assure conformity with applicable government regulations.

**Waste Disposal Method:** Spilled material, unused contents, and empty containers must be disposed of in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

**Precautions to be taken in Handling and Storing:** Keep lid closed when not in use. Product contains amines; do not mix with nitrites. Keep in cool, dry, ventilated storage. Store separate from strong acids and oxidizers. Do not freeze.

**Other Precautions:** KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN!
