2. Hazards Identification

Emergency overview **WARNING!**

4. First Aid Measures

First aid procedures

Eye contact Any material that contacts the eye should be washed out immediately with water. If easy to do, remove contact lenses. Get medical attention if symptoms persist.

Protection of firefighters

6. Accidental Release Measures
